## **Import, Transit and Export of Scheduled Agricultural Products Regulation Notice No. 8 (Amendments) Effective 25<sup>th</sup> August 2022**

### **1.0 Registration**

Importers, Exporters and Transistors of all scheduled agricultural products are required to apply and register for the year.

All products whether attracting a levy or not shall pay a permit fee not exceeding E250.00.

### **2.0 Payment of Permits**

All payments for permits shall be made prior to issuance of the permit and all payments shall be made through the bank (bank deposits, or electronical) as well as using mobile money transfers. No cash payments shall be accepted at NAMBoard offices.

### **3.0 Validity of Permits**

Import permits	- Valid for 30 days
Transit permits	- Valid for 30 days
Export permits	- Valid for 180 days (6 months)

### **4.0 Permit Fees**

Import permit	- E250.00
Transit permit	- E550.00
Export permit	- Free of charge

### **6.0 Responsibility**

- ✓ Permits are a property of NAMBoard; Importers are responsible for their safe keeping. Issuance of permit shall be ceased should a trader repeatedly lose permits.
- ✓ A non-refundable search fee of E150.00 will be charged for lost permit.
- ✓ Borrowing, sharing or renting out of permits is illegal. A penalty of E2,500.00 will be charged to the permit holder if found to be misusing the permit.

### **7.0 Offence and Penalty**

A penalty of 30% of invoice value will be charged on non/under/false declaration and smuggled scheduled products.
